Blanc de Blancs Grand Cru Brut Millésime Collection

Quietly in the shadows of the larger houses in the Côte de Blancs, vine-growing Champagne artisans like Jean-Michel Turguy are crafting character-rich wines based on the traditions of past winemaking generations. Turguy sets himself apart with wines that do more than just reflect the Mesnil style—sumptuous, sensual and richly flavored—but faithfully capture the true character of the region’s unparalleled terroir, a vibrant personality often muted by mass-producing Champagne houses. For more than 130 years, the Turguy family has grown Chardonnay grapes on these chalky soils, and because of this, they can certainly claim to be more than acquainted with the true soul and substance of Mesnil.

BLEND: 100% Chardonnay

VINEYARDS: Multiple, small vineyard 100% Grand Cru parcels in and around the town of Le Mesnil sur Oger, in the Côte des Blancs. Soils are pure chalk (ancient fossilized marl and limestone).

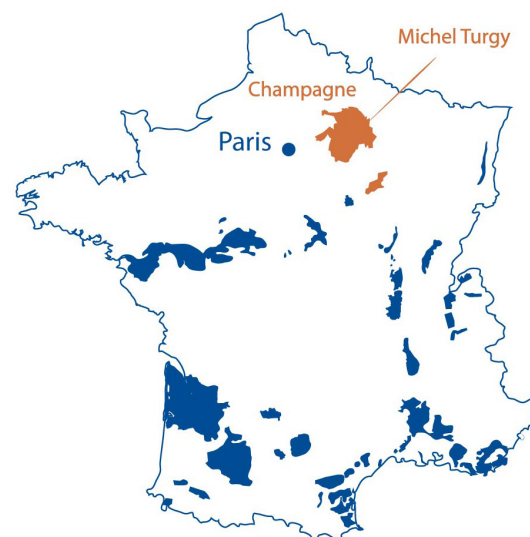
AGE OF VINES: 20-30 years

WINEMAKING: Hand-harvested. Pressed in an ancient wooden upright press. Fermented on indigenous yeasts in temperature-controlled, stainless steel tanks. Second fermentation in bottle (Méthode Champenoise). Zero dosage.

TASTING IMPRESSIONS: Aromas of gardenia, honeysuckle, brioche. Flavors of lemon curd, sea salt, toast. Fine-grained and savory.

PAIRING SUGGESTIONS: As an aperitif; with sushi or other delicate seafood

NOTES: Jean-Michel Turguy in 2015 released a limited selection of non-dosage vintage wines that have been stored in the estate’s cool cellars since bottling. Regardless of vintage, all wines were disgorged before shipment.



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
